Airport opponents seek higher profile

A group opposing a general aviation airport proposed for Oldham County plans to be more visible in the community, with booths at Oldham County Day and the Oldham fair in July, member Jim Pearson said.

Pearson said No Oldham Airport will "be more aggressive" in its petition against an airport.

He said about 15 people came to the group's meeting last Thursday. Its next meeting date will be posted on the group's Web site, www.nooldhamairport.com.

An Airport Board is studying several concerns with the project, including its economic impact. Earlier this year, the board decided to step away from its site-selection process to focus on those issues, saying it would not return to the process until they are addressed.
