Oldham board votes to end airport study

The six-member board that's been studying the possibility of an airport in Oldham County for more than a year will soon ask county leaders to dissolve the group and end the study.

The Airport Board voted unanimously to make the recommendation after a survey of Oldham residents showed that most of them do not support developing an airport for corporate and private planes.

The board plans to present the recommendation during the Fiscal Court meeting at 2 p.m. on Tuesday, Feb. 17.

"This clearly tells us which direction to take as a local government, and what the community really wants," board member Bob Sargis said of the survey.
