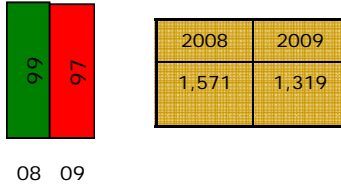

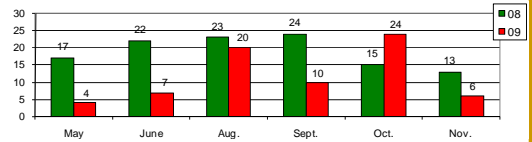

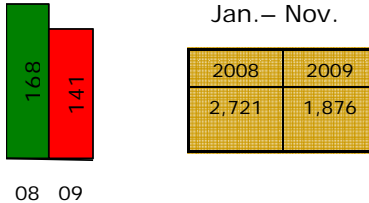


Residential Permits (New Housing Units)
