

PURPOSE OF THE MEETING

Thank you for attending today's public meeting. Staffs from Oldham County Planning and Development and our consultants (URS) are available to answer your questions. We are seeking your input regarding a planned pedestrian and bicycle bridge over I-71 in Buckner. The bridge would be a part of the planned Oldham County Greenway and provide a safe crossing of the interstate. The Oldham County Greenway, when completed will connect LaGrange, Buckner, Crestwood and Pewee Valley.

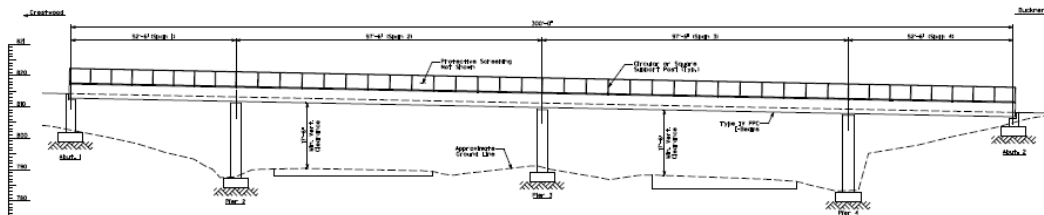
BRIDGE LOCATION

Located in Buckner, near exit 17, the proposed pedestrian and bicycle bridge over I-71 would be parallel to the existing CSX railroad bridge. It would connect to Old Lagrange Road, which is the former Buckner - Crestwood Pike, which was a continuous road prior to the construction of I-71. The bridge will be 10 feet wide.

PROJECT BUDGET

Design	\$80,000
Construction	\$796,853

Dollar amounts are as programmed in the *KIPDA 2007-2011 Transportation Improvement Program*. Matching funds were provided by KYTC through the use of toll credits.



BRIDGE DESIGN ELEMENTS

It is the goal of the bridge design to have aesthetic value within the budget of the project. The following are considerations for the bridge:

- **BRIDGE DECK**
 - Concrete Beam



- **RAIL TYPES**
 - Steel Truss



- **FENCING (SCREENING)**
 - Post with Decorative
